Please help your child with the quick recognition of sounds and words from both phases. In our phonics sessions we will be focusing on applying these when writing so please encourage this at home too. We regularly assess phonics and plan activities to support children's individual needs.



#### Family learning

Thank you for the leaves you have sent in for our treemendous tree. Please send these back to school so they can form part of your child's learning journey. Ideas for things to comment on:

- Physical activities—climbing, ball skills
- Use of technology
- Talking about the environment and changes they see

- Ask them to retell stories
- Writing numbers
