Academy Conversion Update

Over the past year, we have continued to work closely with the recently formed 'Uttoxeter Learning Trust'.

Although we intended to join as a founder member of the Multi-Academy Trust, issues arose which meant that we, along with All Saints' First School, Church Leigh, chose to delay our conversion to become an Academy and join the ULT.

Hutchinson Memorial, along with 3 other schools: All Saints' First; Oldfields Hall Middle and Ryecroft Middle have been working with the ULT Board and the DfE towards becoming the next cohort of schools to convert to Academies and join the ULT. We are aiming for January 1st 2018 as a conversion date.

I will keep Parents updated as to our progress in achieving this over the weeks ahead.
