### Summary of Funding for PE and Sports spending 2015/16

The Government has given every Primary School funding to develop Physical Education and competitive sport.

In our school we are using this funding by working with Castele Consultancy and Progressive Sports to:

Increase the amount of competition sport in which our children participate. Castele Consultancy £1,500

Extend and subsidise additional sports clubs and activities for children outside the curriculum.
